## Fairseat News – 15 May 2020

- LINK Meeting Saturday, 16<sup>th</sup> May at 12 noon in the Widgery Room. This will be to receive an update from Ben on the present situation, hear what the Fairseat board have been busy doing and to hear what proposals are being looked at for the future. Ben will also be wanting to hear about concerns that residents may have. I think this is an important meeting and I urge residents to attend and be in a position to ask any questions they may have and voice their concerns or suggestions.
- Resident News we have 2 more birthdays in May with Barbara (20/5) & Edna (27/5). Then in June we have no less that 5 residents in their 80's celebrating so I think we may have to practice social distancing and look to a garden lunch if the sun comes out.
- Fairseat lockdown It is now 2 months since our last LINK meeting when residents agreed to start a lockdown process for Fairseat. Much has happened in that time & we have just begun our first rotation of annual leave for staff. We have a quarantine room plus a tent for staff who are coming back from leave. We have developed a 14-day cycle for staff to come and go with a planned absence of 28 days each. Carolyne and Alice both completed their 14-day quarantine period and we now have two carers, Lilian & Josephine and Leonard, our gardener, isolating for the next 14 days.
- **Link** the residents' social calendar continues to be full of activities & it is great to see so much participation. We are still looking for a 2<sup>nd</sup> boules' set if anyone has one that we can use & any retired putters for our staff to play clock golf with thanks?
- Drinking water Nairobi water supply have had a major disaster with their supply line from Sasumua Dam into Nairobi damaged by a landslide in the Aberdares.
   Apparently, access is a challenge with a walk of over 10km through the forest to get to the damaged pipeline and as a result we have had no supply for weeks and it looks like it could be a few more weeks yet before we receive any. We only use this for drinking water but can I please ask everyone to make sure we do not waste water.
- **Staff** we commiserate with John Kamau, our maintenance man, who lost his mother yesterday after a long illness. He will now take a fortnight's leave until he is able to enter our quarantine tent on Tuesday, 26/5 & start work 14 days later on 9/6.
- Fairseat Rainfall My apologies for the error in the rain records in the last news. We somehow lost April figures? Anyway, these are correct now up to & including 15/5 which shows that as of mid-May, we have already had 89% of our annual average.

Jan – 132mm over 20 days Vs Average of 66mm over 4.9 days

Feb – 110mm over 8 days Vs Average of 48 mm over 4.1 days

Mar - 206mm over 14 days Vs Average of 105mm over 8.6 days

Apr – 323mm over 19 days Vs an Average of 208 over 15.6 days

May to date – 133mm over 12 days Vs Average of 157mm over 12.7 days for the full month

**Year to date** – 905.75mm over 72 days Vs Ave of 585mm over 45 days until end of May.

- Astronomical events of interest we have a new moon due on Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May. Then we have a full moon due on Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> June which also coincides with a Penumbral Lunar Eclipse visible in Nairobi on both 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> June, starting at about 8pm and at its maximum effect at about 10.25pm. Then on Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> June we will have the June Solstice, the shortest day of the year in southern hemisphere where the sun is directly above the Tropic of Cancer. We also have a Partial Solar Eclipse starting at about 6.45am on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June and at its maximum effect at about 7.45 am remember not to look into the sun without proper protection.
