Do not attend weddings, funerals, church services or any other gatherings with a lot of people. Wear your masks when you are out & wear them correctly. Be careful about maintaining social distancing when you are out & about
- Track & Trace we are not controlling outside visitors as before but we do need to keep a record of who visits whom and when. This is in case we have a positive virus infection and we need to know who has been in recent contact for track & trace purposes. Please ask your visitors to let the office or Ben know about visits. Likewise, whenever residents need to go out of Fairseat it is important to know where you are going. Simply indicating that you are going to Muthaiga will not assist us if we have to follow up a positive case more detail is required please.
