Fairseat News – 07th November 2020

- **November & December birthdays and Wedding anniversaries** – In November we have 7 residents celebrating birthdays with **Joan's birthday on 14th** and then **Gay** on 15th, **Mike C.** on the 16th, **Yvonne M-S** on the 17th, **Diana & Fiona** share a birthday on the 20th and **Delphine's** birthday is on 26th. - **Quarantine** - Residents in quarantine at the moment include Joe & Gay and Mike & Vi who are all on Day 1 of 7 after medically related visits. John & Elizabeth are both on Day 1 of 14. Chip, Anja and Andy are all on Day 2 of 14. Debonnaire is 3/14, Neil is 4/7, Yvonne M-S is 4/14 and Ben is 9/14. So please be aware of people in reflective jackets, help each other to maintain responsible behaviour, wear your masks and keep safe distance from others at all times. We all want to keep each other safe and well and this relies on responsible behaviour. **Residents in quarantine cannot go into the dining room, cannot go into the Widgery Room for videos or other meetings, and cannot sit near or together with non-quarantining residents whilst watching clock golf or boule. They must wear their masks when outside their residences and they must not go inside residences of other residents. Any uncertainty, please speak to Ben.**
- **Track & Trace** – we are not controlling outside visitors as before but we do need to keep a record of who visits whom and when. This is in case we have a positive virus infection and we need to know who has been in recent contact for track & trace purposes. Please ask your visitors to let the office or Ben know about visits. Likewise, whenever residents need to go out of Fairseat it is important to know where you are going. Simply indicating that you are going to Muthaiga will not assist us if we have to follow up a positive case – more detail is required please.
- **Residents** – Joe & Gaye have had their two daughters to stay recently but they have both returned to the UK. Joan is in Tsavo staying with her daughter & promising to come back next Tuesday. Anja is safely back from France where she had to go at short notice. Ben & Fiona had 2 weeks with friends from Zimbabwe visiting them and Fiona is now in Zambia visiting her father - expected back on Wednesday. Steve & Yvonne are expecting their son for a short visit.

However, the day is intended to remember all the wars that have scarred our past and the bravery of the men and women who fought them. **Remembrance Sunday and Armistice Day, which fall on Sunday Nov 8 & Wednesday Nov 11 this year**, offer us all a chance to remember not just those who fought, but what they fought for. The Kenyan branch of the British Legion runs the annual Poppy Appeal, associated with this occasion, which raises money to assist war veterans and maintain war cemeteries in Kenya. **Residents can get their poppies from Debonnaire or the Fairseat office if they wish to support the appeal.**
