## Fairseat News - 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021

- Lockdown and Visitors as per the policy, agreed by the board and distributed to all residents last week, we will permit residents to have unsupervised visits by persons who have been vaccinated at least 21 days ago. Visits must be on the verandah where possible and masks must be worn. Please inform the office, or Ben, of any intention to visit and there is a separate form to be filled in at the gate for visitors seeing residents which is really to have an affirmation of vaccination status.
- Quarantine with our new policies in place, quarantine is now for 10 days for same day medical appointments and 14 days for everything else. Can I encourage residents to avoid being in constant quarantine, where possible. Where you have to go out, can I suggest that you try and combine necessary appointments to the same day so that you avoid extended periods of quarantine. If you have a follow-up appointment with somebody, question as to how important it is for you to actually show up physically and ask if it is possible to simply have the necessary blood tests done and a report from the nurses to avoid physically going in to see the specialist. Residents in quarantine must eat meals in their residences, cannot go in the library or dining room and must mindfully social distance from all staff and residents at all times.

**Clock Golf** - Residents can watch and play clock golf under Mike's watchful eye who is responsible for maintaining safety at all times.

**Boules** - guarantined residents can only watch Boules and not be involved in playing.

**Scrabble & bridge** – can only be played by residents who are NOT in quarantine and are wearing masks.

**Movies/films** – No quarantined residents allowed inside the Widgery Room. They can sit outside the windows to watch if they wish but NOT in the door way.

**Bingo** – No quarantined residents allowed inside the Widgery Room to play Bingo. They can sit and play from outside the windows if they wish.

**Croquet** – who knows what happens at croquet. It is played to Steve's rules and I rely on Yvonne to maintain law & order at all times.

**Pub Nite** – the organisers will arrange outside tables for quarantined residents with social distancing at pub nite. We can only hope that it does not rain.

- Resident birthdays & anniversaries birthdays in May are Chip (on Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup> May), Yvonne S. (13/5), Barbara F. (20/05) and Edna (27/05). We have Philip and Shirley celebrating 66 years of matrimony on 14<sup>th</sup> May followed by Ben & Fiona (34 yrs on 6/6).
