## Fairseat News - Friday 6th July 2021

- Fairseat policy following 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccine the board have agreed to relax the policies Fairseat have had in place to mitigate against the Covid-19 virus. All residents and most staff have had two vaccinations. With this in mind, our policies will change on Friday, 9/7
  - Residents may come and go without restrictions
  - o Residents will not be required to quarantine after external visits, be they medical or social
  - o All residents will be able to use the dining room, the Widgery Room and attend indoor events such as films and church services together.
  - o Residents will be able to have visitors including children.
  - Residents will be able to invite their visitors to stay for meals but they must eat on the veranda or in their residences.
  - Residents will not be required to wear masks in and around Fairseat. Staff will continue to wear masks even though they have all been double vaccinated.
  - Any visitor who has not been "fully" vaccinated will be asked to wear a fluoro jacket when inside Fairseat and must wear a mask. This will rely upon an honesty system and will be reviewed in due course.
  - Visitors who have to wear fluoro vests are not permitted in the dining room, Widgery room or inside residences without specific permission from the manager. All social activities should be outside or on a verandah.
  - The nurses will continue to check resident temperatures daily.
  - The gate security staff will continue to check temperatures of the staff, visitors, the builder's staff and delivery personnel when they enter at the gate.

The board have urged me to emphasise to all residents that, just because they have been vaccinated, they are not completely safe against being infected with Covid-19. The vaccine makes them less likely to be infected, less likely to be very sick if they are infected, even more less likely to require hospitalisation and very unlikely to die compared to their situation if they were not vaccinated. But, there are always exceptions and residents need to appreciate that they generally have a multiple number of co-morbidities that make them much more likely to become part of the exceptions than the average man in the street. Age is a good example to start with! So, please, we ask both residents & staff to continue to be cautious in their behaviour & avoid risky situations when possible.

- Residents Edwin continues to recover from his recent operation. Anja is safely back from Greece and
  has had her second vaccine. Angela's daughter is coming to see her from USA. Delphine has had her
  daughter and grandsons visiting from the northern hemisphere.
- **Resident birthdays & anniversaries** –We have no resident birthdays at all in July. However, we will still be able to celebrate as on 14<sup>th</sup> July we have the 32<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the date when Vivien Horwood donated the land upon which Fairseat now sits. I think it will be a suitable occasion for us to celebrate our second vaccination and remember Vivian's extraordinary generosity.
- Remembering residents we remember our major benefactor, Vivien Horwood, who died 19/7/1989, Jeanette Chubb (20/7/17), Liz Fowler (24/7/17), Tobina Cole (27/4/16) and Libo Barton (30/7/17).
