Vaccinations – in the Widgery Room on Friday 25th June 2021 from 12 noon. We have been informed a short time ago that the Ministry of Health will attend at Fairseat to give vaccines for all our residents and staff from 12 noon tomorrow. They expect it to take about 2 hours to complete the 100+ vaccines necessary.

I propose that the vaccinations will take place in the library. I am not familiar with the process but I assume it will be a bit like what we experienced at Gertrude's Hospital in March. Both residents and staff will be vaccinated.

It may be a disaster but I think we need to have a positive approach and be prepared. I suggest that residents come, with or without their carers, shortly after noon and report outside the library. If residents are with their carer, then I expect that they will all be vaccinated together.

Ruth Mumbi is arranging to contact all staff who are not expected on duty tomorrow, for whatever reason, to inform them of the situation and to ask them to attend by 12.30 pm.
